- Individual Life
- Individual Annuity
- Long-Term Care
- Health
- Lender-Placed Auto and Homeowners
- Disability Income
- Private Flood
- Travel
- Short-Term Limited Duration
- Other Health

If your company is required to file an MCAS, the data is requested for the period Jan. 1, 2023 through Dec. 31, 2023. Submissions for private passenger auto, homeowners, individual life, individual annuity, long-term care, lender placed auto and home, disability income, private flood, and travel are due by April 30, 2024. Submissions for health and short-term limited duration are due by May 31, 2024. Submissions for other health are due by June 30, 2024. To determine if your company is required to submit data for one or more of the MCAS lines of business, please review the MCAS Participation Requirements.

To submit your annual statement data, use the online tool available on the NAIC MCAS Webpage.

We recommend that you check the NAIC MCAS website frequently for updates during the data filing process. It is the responsibility of the company to verify that the company's filings meet the requirements of the data request and other documentation available on the NAIC MCAS Web page.

To the extent permitted by applicable state law, your company's data will be kept confidential.

Also, please note that effective Thursday, Jan. 4, MCAS users will be required to use Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA). MFA adds an extra layer of security for users, helping protect against unauthorized access by requiring an additional form of authentication beyond username and password.

After logging in, users will be prompted to set an MFA type of their choice including Okta Verify, Google Authenticator, Voice Call Authentication, Email Authentication, and SMS Authentication.
