1. Adopted its Spring National Meeting Minutes

Bethel made a motion, seconded by Joyce, to adopt the Task Force's March 4 minutes (see NAIC Proceedings – Spring 2025, Receivership and Insolvency (E) Task Force). The motion passed unanimously.

2. Adopted its 2026 Proposed Charges

Stuckey said 2026 proposed charges for the Task Force and its working groups were exposed for a 14-day public comment period ending July 23. No comments were received.

Emmermann made a motion, seconded by Sheridan, to adopt the proposed 2026 charges (Attachment One). The motion passed unanimously.

3. Heard a Report on International Resolution Activities

Wake said the International Association of Insurance Supervisors (IAIS) Resolution Working Group is reviewing and updating the *Application Paper on Recovery Planning* and the *Application Paper on Resolution Powers and Planning*. He said a survey was conducted, and drafting group sessions were held. Wake said there were no significant developments to report. The IAIS Resolution Working Group will meet in September 2025 in Basel, Switzerland.

Wake said he participated in the targeted jurisdictional assessment (TJA) project on the member review panel, which reviewed six jurisdictions. Resolution and resolution planning were key issues for this round of the TJA, like the first TJA in which the U.S. was assessed. He said the aggregate TJA report is in the process of being finalized.

4. Received the Report of the Receivership Financial Analysis (E) Working Group
