

NAIC Meeting and Event Code of Conduct

The NAIC is committed to maintaining a collaborative culture, the integrity of open meetings, protecting the safety and privacy of attendees, and promoting meaningful engagement at NAIC meetings and events.

Participants in NAIC Meetings and Events, whether virtual or in-person, are expected to refrain from behavior that could be harmful or disruptive to others. Expected behaviors include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Treat all participants with kindness, respect, and courtesy. Communicate and act with consideration, respect, and collaboration.
- Always wear your own official event badge while in designated meeting or event spaces. Do not attempt to access spaces that are not intended for your use or share, alter, or use another attendee's badge.
- Refrain from any harassing or intimidating conduct and from any disruptive or unsafe behavior.
- Engage in constructive dialogue–focus on ideas, not individuals–and respect differing viewpoints.
- Be mindful of your surroundings and the safety and experience of fellow participants.
- If you see something, say something. Promptly report any inappropriate behavior or safety issue to an NAIC team member. Respect the rules, policies, and property of the NAIC and its contracted venues and vendors.
- Comply with instructions from meeting leaders, organizers, security personnel, and other official authorities, as well as all applicable laws and regulations.
- Take photographs and make audio or video recordings only in accordance with NAIC policies.

Any behavior not consistent with this Code of Conduct may have an impact on participation at current or future NAIC meetings and events. The NAIC may report any alleged violations of this policy to appropriate authorities, including the participant's employer.
