For the 2024 data year, the North Dakota Insurance Commissioner requests companies to voluntary submit data in accordance with the Commissioner's authority provided in N.D.C.C. ch. 26.1-03. By submitting data voluntarily, the company acknowledges receipt of this letter, appointment of the NAIC as the Commissioner's representative examiner as provided in N.D.C.C. § 26.1-03-19.3, and understands that no examination report will be issued as specified in 26.1-03-19.4.

If your company is required to file an MCAS, the data is requested for the period Jan. 1, 2024 through Dec. 31, 2024. Submissions for private passenger auto, homeowners, individual life, individual annuity, long-term care, lender placed auto and home, disability income, private flood, travel, and pet are due by April 30, 2025. Submissions for health, short-term limited duration, and other health are due by May 31, 2025. To determine if your company is required to submit data for one or more of the MCAS lines of business, please review the MCAS Participation Requirements.

To submit your annual statement data, use the online tool available on the NAIC MCAS Webpage.

We recommend that you check the NAIC MCAS website frequently for updates during the data filing process. It is the responsibility of the company to verify that the company's filings meet the requirements of the data request and other documentation available on the NAIC MCAS Web page.

To the extent permitted by applicable state law, your company's data will be kept confidential.

After logging in, users will be prompted to enter a code from the MFA type (Okta Verify, Google Authenticator, Voice Call Authentication, Email Authentication, and SMS Authentication) that was set up previously.
