Arizona only has a few comments regarding the Pet Insurance blank:

- Pages 1 and 13 references Travel
- Questions 1-15 on page 5 should be changed to reference question 14, not 13
- The definition for Free Look on page 15 should add the word "policies"; Report the number of policies that were returned...
- The definition of a Wellness Program on page 16: there are brackets to insert language from statute or regulation regarding the definition of the business of insurance. It's unclear if they are looking for comments on a mutually agreed-upon definition. If so, how will this impact the wellness-specific data elements?
