Private Flood Insurance Data Call Letter

To: (All insurers writing private flood insurance)

From: NAIC on behalf of participating states

Insurance regulators in 50 states and the District of Columbia have agreed to participate in a data call to collect data related to private flood insurance. This data will assist state insurance regulators and others in understanding which insurers are writing the coverage, including differences between residential and commercial writings and understanding how much is first-dollar compared to excess and stand-alone compared to endorsements, as well as claims information. Similar data is expected to be collected through the NAIC's Financial Annual Statement and the Market Conduct Annual Statement beginning in 2021.

If your company wrote private flood coverage in any of the Participating Jurisdictions in 2018 or 2019, your company is hereby being requested to complete the private flood insurance data call for the corresponding calendar years of 2018 and/or 2019. For companies domiciled in the State of Maryland, this data call is voluntary.

The Private Flood Insurance Data Call and Definitions and other documentation relevant to the data call can be found on the private flood webpage [ADD LINK]. The data call requests data for the periods Jan. 1, 2018 through Dec. 31, 2018 and Jan. 1, 2019 through Dec. 31, 2019, with data due no later than Aug. 15, 2020. It is the responsibility of the company to verify that the company's filings meet the requirements of the data request.

The information contained in your submission is considered non-confidential. The NAIC reserves the right to publish the data and insights in any format requested by the state departments of insurance.

TO SUBMIT YOUR DATA

A company contact will need to be assigned to file the report in the RDC application. Filing requires a myNAIC account username and password as well as the following role: FLOOD USER PR.

The company contact assigned to submit the data file should send an email to **help@naic.org** requesting:

- myNAIC account setup (if not already setup), and;
- the role FLOOD_USER_PR assigned.

Once the company contact has an account setup and the role assigned, they will be able to log in to the portal from here: https://content.naic.org/industry_private_flood_data_call.htm and submit their 2018 and 2019 files. Each data year requires a separate file and the appropriate data year should be selected in the file.
