1. Adopted Letters Regarding the Conflict Between COBRA and Medicare

The Task Force conducted an e-vote to consider adoption of a letter to the U.S. Congress (Congress) and a letter to the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) regarding the conflict between Medicare and the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 (COBRA) rules that has led to some confusion about which system and set of rules govern eligibility for coverage, as well as how the responsibility for the payment of health care benefits for eligible individuals is determined.

Without objection, the Task Force adopted the comment letter by a vote of 26 to 2.
