Meeting Summary Report

The NAIC/American Indian and Alaska Native Liaison Committee met Nov. 18, 2024. During this meeting, the Liaison Committee:

- 1. Adopted its Summer National Meeting minutes.
- 2. Announced the reaffirmation of its 2024 mission statement for 2025.
- 3. Heard a presentation from the University of Washington School of Medicine and Leavitt Partners on the American Indian Medical Education Strategies (AIMES) Alliance regarding medical access for American Indians and Alaska Natives. This is important as it provides another avenue for outreach that states can use via partnership with the AIMES system.
- 4. Heard a presentation from Tribal First on producer outreach to tribal members providing access to affordable insurance products. The presentation provided insight into the innovations being used to make affordable health care more accessible to all Native Americans and give tribal leaders the ability to self-govern the health care arena.
- 5. Heard a panel discussion from Commissioner Glen Mulready (OK) and Director Lori K. Wing-Heier (AK) on how state insurance regulators support tribal communities. Commissioner Mulready and Director Wing-Heier also answered questions from attendees.
