Meeting Summary Report

The Antifraud (D) Task Force met Aug. 12, 2025. During this meeting, the Task Force:

1. Adopted its Spring National Meeting minutes.
2. Heard a presentation from the United Brotherhood of Carpenters regarding workers' compensation premium fraud. The presentation addressed the types of fraud witnessed and the financial effects this has caused in the industry.
3. Discussed a letter received from the Coalition Against Insurance Fraud (CAIF) regarding the addition of the long-term care (LTC) fraud category to the Online Fraud Reporting System (OFRS). The Task Force agreed that this category should be added.
4. Adopted the report of the Improper Marketing of Health Insurance (D) Working Group, which met April 24 in regulator-to-regulator session, pursuant to paragraph 3 (specific companies, entities, or individuals) of the NAIC Policy Statement on Open Meetings, to discuss improper marketing of health insurance. The Working Group also met May 22. During this meeting, it took the following action:
 - A. Heard a presentation from the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Association (BCBSA) addressing market destabilizing schemes, residential treatment center fraud, and the impact on the federal Affordable Care Act (ACA) health market.
 - B. Held a roundtable open discussion on the improper marketing of health insurance.
5. Heard reports from the CAIF and the National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB) on antifraud activity.
