Meeting Summary Report

The Antifraud (D) Task Force met March 24, 2026. During this meeting, the Task Force:

1. Adopted its 2025 Fall National Meeting minutes.
2. Heard a presentation from Verisk on its history; its ClaimSearch tool, a database and fraud detection platform for property/casualty (P/C) insurance; and the customers it serves. The presentation focused on Verisk resources and position to assist states with insurance fraud detection.
3. Heard a presentation from the Coalition Against Insurance Fraud (Coalition) on the results of its long-term care (LTC) fraud survey. The presentation addressed the growing threat of LTC fraud.
4. Received an update from the Improper Marketing of Health Insurance (D) Working Group. The Working Group will continue to meet monthly in regulator-to-regulator session, pursuant to paragraph 3 (specific companies, entities, or individuals) of the NAIC Policy Statement on Open Meetings, to discuss improper marketing of health insurance.
5. Received an update from the Antifraud Technology (D) Working Group. The Working Group is collaborating with regulators and industry organizations to update the NAIC Online Fraud Reporting System's (OFRS') list of fraud schemes and insurance types.
6. Heard reports from the National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB) and the CAIF on antifraud activity. The reports addressed legislative activity, state and federal activity and best practices to assist with the fight against insurance fraud.
