The Regulatory Treatment Analysis Services ("RTAS") process used to evaluate Schedule BA Private Funds under <u>"The Regulatory Treatment Analysis Service – Emerging Investment Vehicle" section in Part Two</u> and the "NAIC Fund Lists" section in Part Three of the Purposes and Procedures Manual of the NAIC Investment Analysis Office (the "Purposes and Procedures Manual) only results in the assignment of a preliminary NAIC Designations to the Schedule BA Fund.

Preliminary NAIC Designations are indications of the likely SVO response if the Schedule BA Fund were purchased by an insurer and filed with the SVO for assignment of an NAIC Designation and are based on preliminary documentation and therefore cannot be used to report the Fund to the NAIC or state insurance regulators.
