

NAIC NATIONAL MEETING NON-REGULATOR GUEST POLICY UPDATE

Effective June 15, 2022, the NAIC is implementing a new guest registration policy for national meetings.

Definition

Meeting guests are people who accompany a registered meeting attendee and do not have a business or industry interest in the event, such as friends or family members.

Guest Registration Fee

Non-regulators may register guests for a fee of \$150 per guest. Business colleagues do not qualify for guest registration.

Guest Policy

- Registered guests may attend only the Opening Session, Welcome Reception, and the Executive/Plenary Session. Event staff will be posted at entries to check badges. No badge, no entry.
- Individuals who are not registered as guests are not permitted in any sessions, events, or official meeting areas.
- Only guests of commissioners, directors, and superintendents are permitted to enter the regulator-only dining areas.
